

COVID-19 Code of Conduct for LDSC

The requirements in this document are minimum requirements and everyone visiting the Club must act responsibly and in accordance with them. Due to the unique nature of this pandemic, all who visit the Club must recognize that collectively we are doing our best and cannot be held liable should anyone fall sick of COVID-19 or a related illness, after coming to the Club.

1. Members experiencing any symptoms associated with COVID-19, or who have been in contact in the past 14 days with someone displaying such symptoms, shall not visit the club. Consult <https://covid-19.ontario.ca/> for further guidance.
2. Respect all current local, provincial and federal government regulations and public health guidelines, including:
 - a. Physical distancing: Maintain a minimum of 2 m of separation at all times between individuals not in the same household. **Physical distancing is the most effective tool for keeping everyone safe.** If the number of members present will not allow for appropriate physical distancing, wait in your vehicle or return at a later time.
 - b. Maximum group sizes for public events, social events and other gatherings.
 - c. Good hand hygiene. Please bring your own hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes.
 - d. Appropriate use and disposal of masks and other PPE when necessary. <https://www.cma.ca/use-masks-public-guideline>.
3. Take all garbage home, including used disinfectant wipes, disposable gloves and masks, as well as recycling and compost.
4. Watch for and follow signage and other directives from the club board of directors, and recognize that as the situation evolves, requirements may change.
5. Refrain from using club equipment or facilities that have been designated as closed.
6. If the clubhouse or parts of the clubhouse are open for member use, respect club mandated limits on the number of individuals permitted inside.
7. If any club owned facilities or equipment are available to be used, perform any club mandated cleaning requirements after use.
8. Use the LDSC Incident Reporting Procedure and Form to report any issues or incidents with compliance to this code of conduct.
9. This code of conduct applies to all members, staff, contractors and guests.
10. Members who do not comply with this code of conduct will be reprimanded, and may have their membership revoked at the discretion of the board.

Rules Specific to the First Phase of Opening

1. A senior member of every household wishing to access club grounds must email secretary@ldsc.ca stating "All LDSC members of our household accept the COVID-19 Code of Conduct and agree to abide by its directives." before arriving at the club.
2. Members may come to the club **to prepare boats for the season.**
3. Facilities maintenance may be performed by staff and specific House and Grounds volunteers.
4. **The clubhouse, including the bathrooms, shed are all closed.** Outdoor infrastructure is not being cleaned and should not be used.
5. The BBQ shall not be used.
6. Carry out all your own garbage.
7. Club boats are not to be used.
8. There are no rescue boats available.
9. Be aware that since March 28, 2020, the Ontario Government has banned gatherings of more than 5 people (unless they are in the same household). The emergency order which permits this ban has been extended until June 2, 2020. It is possible it will be extended again. LDSC considers individuals working on separate boats to be different groups, provided a minimum of 2 m spacing is maintained at all times.
