


Alcohol Consumption Policy

(Lac Deschenes Sailing Club)

Lac Deschenes Sailing Club is a private non-profit organization dedicated to providing opportunities to pursue all kinds of on-the-water activities for all age groups.

In order to provide a safe and comfortable environment for all Members and guests, it is required that all Members and guests strictly abide by this Alcohol Consumption Policy. Namely that:

1. The responsible consumption of beer and wine alcoholic beverages is permitted on the Club's premises for people who are 21 years of age or over. It is the responsibility of any Club Member to ensure compliance with all Federal, Provincial and Municipal laws concerning the consumption of alcohol.
2. Alcoholic beverages are permitted for organized Club events and other gatherings, such as wedding receptions
3. The consumption of hard alcohol on Club premises is strictly prohibited.
4. Beer and wine only may be consumed on the Club's premises.
5. Beer and wine may be consumed only by a Club Member, guest or member of a gathering that is 19 years of age or older.
6. Guests under age 19 may not acquire, possess, or consume alcohol. Nor may other persons furnish alcohol to anyone under 19 or permit any underage consumption.
7. Alcohol may not be sold on Club premises.
8. Advertising and publicity for events may not mention the availability of alcoholic beverages even if they are to be served at the event.
9. Any person who chooses to drink alcoholic beverages should be advised that he or she is expected to do so responsibly and at his/her own risk.
10. Both Members and guests will be asked to leave if they fail to comply with these guidelines or if their behavior infringes on the rights of other guests can result in their immediate removal from the Club's premises and the possible revocation of Membership for repeated offences.
11. The strict adherence to this Policy is a condition of Club Membership. Furthermore compliance with this Alcohol Consumption Policy will help to ensure that both other Members and guests have a safe and comfortable place to relax and enjoy themselves.
