



Winter Use of Clubhouse

Any member wishing to use the LDSC Clubhouse during the ``Winter`` season (November 1 to March 31) will complete an ``LDSC Member's Use/Rental of Club Facilities`` form after communicating with the Secretary or designate about the event.

The above is required regardless of the size of the event. ``Casual`` or drop-in use of the Clubhouse during this period by small groups of members will be permitted but only following communication with the Secretary or designate. This restriction is due to the random use of the wood stove and the need to ensure The Board has a record of use and of responsible parties.

Given the winter conditions and the shutdown of facilities, members using the Clubhouse must be aware that

1. All potable water needed for said activities must be brought to the club.
2. No water shall be put down sink drains or toilets as they are protected with winter antifreeze
3. Users must be aware there are no toilet facilities available at the club.
4. The Club will not maintain ploughed access from Lois into the Club during the Winter Season
5. Members may use firewood and kindling stored at the Club only in the stove for the purpose of heating the Clubhouse during use.
6. Members using the wood stove shall exercise extreme caution and will not build a fire that shall overheat the stove and shall ensure that all embers are extinguished before leaving the Clubhouse at the end of the event.
7. Members may use other facilities within the Clubhouse such as the stove, microwaves, refrigerator exercising caution with these appliances.
8. Auxiliary electric, propane or kerosene heaters are not permitted to be used in the Club House at any time.
