

# COVID-19 Code of Conduct for LDSC

The requirements in this document are minimum requirements and everyone visiting the Club must act responsibly and in accordance with them. Due to the unique nature of this pandemic, all who visit the Club must recognize that collectively we are doing our best and cannot be held liable should anyone fall sick of COVID-19 or a related illness, after coming to the Club.

1. **Screening:** Before arriving at LDSC, all members and guests shall perform the Ontario Government COVID Screening for customers at <https://covid-19.ontario.ca/screening/customer/>. Employees and contractors shall complete the Ontario Government COVID Screening for Workers <https://covid-19.ontario.ca/screening/worker/>. Only individuals who pass the screening and shall only enter LDSC premises. Consult <https://covid-19.ontario.ca/> for further guidance.
2. **Public Health Requirements:** Respect all current local, provincial and federal government regulations and public health guidelines, including:
  - a. Physical distancing: Maintain a minimum of 2 m of separation at all times between individuals not in the same household. **Physical distancing is the most important tool for keeping everyone safe.** If the number of members present will not allow for appropriate physical distancing, wait in your vehicle or return at a later time.
  - b. Mask Use: **Masks are mandatory indoors and whenever physical distancing of 2 m might not be possible, both indoors and outdoors.**
  - c. Maximum group sizes for public events, social events and other gatherings.
  - d. Good hand hygiene. Please bring your own hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes.
3. Take all garbage home, including used disinfectant wipes, disposable gloves and masks, as well as recycling and compost.
4. Watch for and follow signage and other directives from the club board of directors, and recognize that as the situation evolves, requirements may change.
5. Refrain from using club equipment or facilities that have been designated as closed.
6. If the clubhouse or parts of the clubhouse are open for member use, respect club mandated limits on the number of individuals permitted inside.
7. If any club owned facilities or equipment are available to be used, perform any club mandated cleaning requirements after use.
8. Use the LDSC Incident Reporting Procedure and Form to report any issues or incidents with compliance to this code of conduct.
9. The installation and use of the Government of Canada COVID Alert app is recommended.
10. This code of conduct applies to all members, staff, contractors and guests.
11. Members who do not comply with this code of conduct will be reprimanded, and may have their membership revoked at the discretion of the board.
